



Dear Parents/Guardians:

Thank you for your interest in the Webster Montessori School. We are certain that your child's educational experience here will be extremely worthwhile and will provide a solid foundation for all of his or her future successes. By choosing Webster Montessori School, you have made a commitment to a fine early education program. The enclosed brochure briefly describes the philosophies and policies of our school.

The years between eighteen months and six are a time when toddler and primary children are particularly sensitive to nature, order, and the world around them. The children in our primary school are introduced to the community of the world. Our program offers a unique multi-age, multi-cultural community that emphasizes independence, grace and courtesy, appreciation and respect for differences among people. Our Montessori classrooms are equipped with special materials that enable children to explore their environment and develop their potential.

A qualified, nurturing Montessori teacher and a classroom assistant head each classroom and guide children as they develop at their own pace. Children start school at age eighteen months and can remain with us until age 11. Toddlers attend the program from 8:45 a.m. to 11:40 a.m., Monday through Friday. For three and four year olds, classes are conducted five days a week from 8:45 to 11:45 a.m. We offer an extended day program, 8:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., for those children who have completed the first two years of the primary program. Additionally, our elementary program services children ages 6-11, from 8:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.

Augmenting our Montessori classrooms is our wrap-around care program for children three through eleven years. Our wrap-around care teachers provide a loving and developmentally appropriate approach to child nurturing. Our wrap-around care program offers convenient before and after school, wrap-around services or full-day service (*school breaks and summer*) from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for the entire year. Alumni students are welcomed to attend all summer Montessori programs.

Our school is located at 1310 Five Mile Line Road. It is within seconds from Route 104's and Plank Road. We are minutes from the eastern suburbs of Monroe County, the City of Rochester and outlying towns in Wayne county. Convenient location, reasonable prices and an excellent school and wrap-around care program demonstrate our continuing service to the parents and children of our community.
